Informative 18 –General Information and Organization

Salvador – October 31st, 2019.

Dear participants,

On this informative there are some general information regarding competition and Cimatec itself, please be aware that any information can be updated at any time and changes will be informed through briefings, Instagram or any other possible means.

General Information

- 2019 competition starts on Nov 01st, the Cimatec however will be open for receiving the participants from Oct 30th, 10am and will be closed on Nov 3rd, at 17 o'clock
- The “Cimatec 4” building will be available for the participants to accommodate, the building can support approximately 320 people, the Staff won't take part in accommodation share unless there's any conflict to be resolved
- The team can bring non-subscribed members as visitors, please be aware that they will have limited to no access to team boxes during the competition, they will also be allowed to accommodate with team at CIMATEC but, in the event of accommodation reaching its maximum capacity, these **extra non-registered participants may be removed from accommodation** as the preference will be given to competition volunteers and subscribed team members, teams should have a back-up plan in case this happens
- Due to limited space, we do not recommend bringing any camping equipment due to its size, please bring only your air mattresses and bed sheets, that way we can accommodate more people on the same space
- Due to the huge incidence of mosquitoes the committee strongly recommends the teams to bring repellent and electric rackets
- It is strictly forbidden to damage/alter the available infrastructure, penalties may be applied if necessary
- Be aware that during the whole event, teams and team members are responsible for its own belongings. The Committee strongly recommends to have all of your personal and valuable items locked on your buses/cars during the day, we also recommend that every team always keep at least one member on each box to take care of equipment, tools, personal belonging and any other item; Although Cimatec is a private university, the access is open for general public and its



students so there will be non-event related people walking around who could seize the opportunity to subtract any of your possessions.

- Power supply voltage is **220V** throughout the site;
- Staff recommends bringing extension cords since the power outlet may be away from your boxes/beds;
- Keep trucks, buses and vehicles parked on the correct area indicated further below on this informative;
- SENAI-CIMATEC working hours goes from 07am to 10pm, the security team is allowed to block your exit/entrance if you're out of these hours;
- There's no facilities around the Cimatec which are within walking distances, if the team needs to leave for grocery shopping or any other reason we recommend that it uses the bus, taxi, Uber or any other motorized mean;
- Please keep all areas as clean as possible, trash bin will be available around the site;

Competition Information

- Design and Management Presentation will take place at Senai's auditorium on Cimatec 3 building and accessible for everyone (including Cimatec's students);
- The presentations time slot are the time the presentations are supposed to start, the committee strongly recommends to arrive at least 10min earlier.
- For all the other evaluations there are no planned time slots, each team is responsible by its own time keeping, by the end of evaluation window the evaluation will end and all teams will be removed from it.
- The Arena will be open from 10h45 to 13h45, in which only the vehicle already set to go will be allowed to perform the evaluation, all the other in line will be expelled regardless of having extra passages to make, the arena will reopen by 14h15 for the Super Prime and all the teams who wants to join need to present in line by 14h15
- Being in line on the arena does not grant access to the evaluation;
- All dynamic evaluations will not take place within Cimatec's facilities, it will happen in another location 1,5km away, please plan yourself to make the relocation safely, under no circumstances the prototypes will be allowed to drive on the streets, the teams should use its own vehicle for transportation
- The committee recommends teams with trucks to allow other teams to load their prototypes to it during the transportation to arena area, if the team has no mean of transporting there will be one truck with the committee available for it but delays may be expected as it will be shared with other teams;

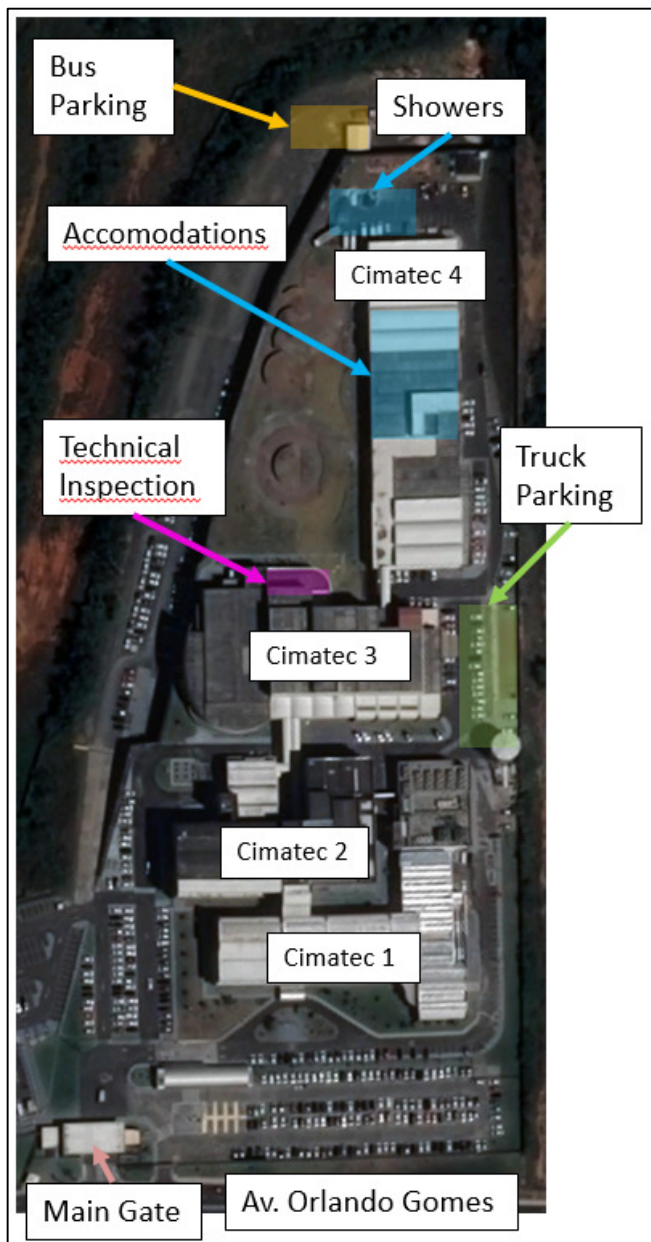
SENAI-Cimatec Code of Conduct

- The SENAI-Cimatec is a private institution with very specific and rigid code of conduct and rules, all of their rules are to be followed by everyone at the university(including but not limited to team members, volunteers, professors, visitors, friends, family members and truck/bus drivers);
